I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of October
A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Francis A. Merritt
I was convicted under the name of Frank A. Merrill.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John Randolph.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except
no other convictions
