under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Petty Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Nov.  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Tanner presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to a term of six months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail
