Application of Squire Rutherford 4509

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole to Sister and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the first day of February A. D. 1927, at Fillmore Utah County of Millard and State of Utah, in Fifth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 1 to 20 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Oliver Giles prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Squire Rutherford I was convicted under the name of Squire Rutherford

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Leonard Thornton

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
