Application of Squire Rutherford No. 4809

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment ~~in~~ on Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of February, A. D. 1927, at Fillmore County of Millard and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas H. Burton presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-Honorable George H. Lunt prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Squire Rutherford I was convicted under the name of Squire Rutherford

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Leonard Thornton.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
