Application of GEORGE DALY

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in county jail  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of possession of intoxicating liquor.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of November  
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to sixty days in the county jail  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable Calvin W. Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Daly  
I was convicted under the name of George Daly
