Application of Deloss Bradshaw #4835

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of March A. D. 1927, at Beaver City County of Beaver and State of Utah, in the fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas H. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 1 to 20 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable George H. Lund prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Deloss Bradshaw I was convicted under the name of Deloss Bradshaw

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am now serving.
