I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows: (on Parole)

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of March
A. D. 1931, at St George County of Washington
and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Henry H. Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to imprisonment for one & three
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison
for one year, and have been
on parole for one year since.

Fourth-Honorable A. L. Larson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is He Loss Bradshaw
