I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Adultery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of March
A. D. 1931, at St. George County of Washington
and State of Utah, in 5th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Frederick Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to from Monday to three
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
on the 29th day of March and
have served two and a half years

Fourth-Honorable A. L. Larson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Bradshaw

I was convicted under the name of W. L. Bradshaw

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Clarence Moore, who was
Released on Jan 1932

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as Rekind
shown
