Application of S. Kashiwagi No. 4859

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of May,
A. D. 1927, at Price, Utah County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to ten years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sekichi Kashiwagi
I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
