Application of Sekichi Kashiwagi No.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3 rd. day of May A. D. 1927, at Price Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7 th. District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Keiler prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sekichi Kashiwagi I was convicted under the name of Sekichi Kashiwagi
