Application of George Pugmire #4672

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination or parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Statutory Offense.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of March A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles George Pugmire. I was convicted under the name of Ditto.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
