First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of October  
A. D. 1927, at Emery County of Wasatch  
and State of Utah, in 7th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Fred Keller presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to from one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at  
Salt Lake Sugar House

Fourth-Honorable George Christensen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ansie Kimber  
I was convicted under the name of Ansie Kimber
