First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of voluntary manslaughter

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of Oct  
A. D. 1927, at basaldale County of Emery  
and State of Utah, in seventh District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christerson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to from one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Ansie Kimber
