I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Petit Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of February A. D. 1932, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in _____ Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge H. Wolfe presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six Months in the Salt Lake County Jail, with time from arrest on Dec. 17th, 1931, allowed and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail, Feb. 15th, 1932, where I have been since Dec. 18th, 1931
