I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION OF SENTENCE and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a ~~term of imprisonment~~ ON PAROLE under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of June A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the State Prison

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Nick Walker

I was convicted under the name of Nick Walker

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harry Miller and self.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
