Application of. Pete Chock #4906

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of September  
A. D. 1927, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Kimball  
George H. Parker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 6 months to  
3 years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Ferguson.  
I was convicted under the name of Pete Chock

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
