Application of Joseph Leonard West #1177

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17 th day of June A. D. 1927, at Duchesene County of Duchesene and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Parker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable R. J. Larson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Leonard West. I was convicted under the name of Joseph Leonard West.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
