I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison of Utah, and now on parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of ~~persistent violation of~~ Title 54

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the fourth day of December A. D. 1924, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George P. Parker presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to not less than three months nor more than two years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison at Salt Lake City, Utah for 117 days.

Fourth--Honorable M. R. Pope District Attorney prosecuted the case.
