and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of September,
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Lee B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Samuel Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Herbert Hubbard Bradley

I was convicted under the name of H. G. Hamilton

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
Salt Lake City, Robbery, September 8th, 1921.
