First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Fourteenth day of November A. D. 1927, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in Third Jud. Court. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Ten Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison. Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is ANGUS HERSHELL NEWTON. I was convicted under the name of ANGUS HERSHELL NEWTON.
