Application of Ed. Grounds #4939

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of December, A. D. 1927, at Provo County of Duchesne and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Martin M. Larsen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ed. Grounds. I was convicted under the name of Ed. Grounds.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
