Application of El. Grondin No. 151

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon on the conditions that I leave the State and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of December A. D. 1917, at Duchene County of Duchene and State of Utah, in the Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Larsen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable L. B. 1000 prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is El. Grondin I was convicted under the name of El. Grondin

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
