First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of March  
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3rd, Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable W. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ed Jackson  
I was convicted under the name of Ed Jackson
