Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of March 1928
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to One to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Ed Jackson
