Application of Ed Jackson No. 4996

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a re-instatement of parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of March A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M L Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to From One To Twenty Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A A Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ed Jackson I was convicted under the name of Ed Jackson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Two
