Application of ED. JACKSON No. 4996

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION (CONDITIONAL) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of FORGERY

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of MARCH, A. D. 1928, at SALT LAKE CITY County of SALT LAKE and State of Utah, in THE THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. RITCHIE presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to AN INDETERMINATE TERM, and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON.

Fourth-Honorable A. A. DUNCAN prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is ED. JACKSON I was convicted under the name of SAME

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: NONE.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except AS SHOWN BY RECORDS.
