Application of David Bird No. 5004

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of April, A. D. 1928, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Nephi H. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Henry E. Beak prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is David Bird I was convicted under the name of David Bird

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: H. T. Jensen and Ellis Crane.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
