Application of George William Collins.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of December
A. D. 1927, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Ninth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. V. Orin presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
