I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embezzlement.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of December
A. D. 1927, at Price Utah County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen Judge presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Ten Years.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred H. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Joseph Collins.
I was convicted under the name of George William Collins.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Military
offense Desertion.
