under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Fictitious Check

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19 day of June
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L.B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Life, Recommended
1 Year By Judge & District Attorney
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
