Application of George C. Porter #4709

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving the owner the use of his automobile

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of May A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Dist Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Chris Matheson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 90 days to 5 yrs and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George C. Porter I was convicted under the name of

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
