I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 Th. day of September  
A. D. 1926, at Brigham City Utah County of Boxelder  
and State of Utah, in 1st. Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From Six Months To Three Years  
In the Utah State Prison.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Le Roy Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Albert Thomas Crofts

I was convicted under the name of Fred Hansen
