Application of Fred Hansen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of September A. D. 1926, at Brigham City County of Kane and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. S. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From 6 months to Three years in State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Le Roy Brown prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ernest Thomas Craft
I was convicted under the name of Fred Hansen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Second degree Burglary Conviction 1921 Dec. 7th released August 22nd 1922
Receiving Stolen Property Conviction November 3rd 1923 Released January 18 1928
