First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The county jail of Juab County,
State of Utah
/ under conviction and a sentence on a charge of contributing to the delinquency of a
juvenile.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Fifth day of April
A. D. 1928, at Nephi County of Juab
and State of Utah, in the Juvenile Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George H. Worthen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve a term of six months in the county
jail of Juab County, state of Utah, - - - - -
and thereafter was imprisoned in the county jail of Juab County, state of Utah.

Fourth-Honorable Claude Baker, of Eureka, Utah, and P. L. Sanders, County
Attorney of Juab County, Utah, of Nephi, Utah, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ross Huff

I was convicted under the name of Ross Huff

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Robert Foster, Walter Clayson, Wilmer Hutchinson, Bernice

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except for liquor
in my presence and disturbance of the
peace.
