Application of Harry K. Lim #4763

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of October, A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry K. Lim I was convicted under the name of Lee Lim

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.

Note: If released from the Utah State Prison, I am intending to go to Hawaii, and will have sufficient money for the fare to my native land.
