First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary in the Second Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of May
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one twenty
years, Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Edward Timothy Fenton
I was convicted under the name of E. T. Fenton

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand
Larceny in my army 30 months.
Infamous Crime against nature 6 months
in Federal Leavenworth Kas.
