First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second-degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of May A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge E. B. Knight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate term one year to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City, Utah
