Application of Edward T. Fenton No. 4873

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of May A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward T. Fenton I was convicted under the name of Edward T. Fenton

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except What the Record shows.
