Application of E. J. Fenton

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of May A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 2 Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. H. Felt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to not less than one year to no more than twenty and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward Timothy Fenton I was convicted under the name of E. J. Fenton

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as records show
