First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of May
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth--Honorable J. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Pryor Baird

I was convicted under the name of Frank Blair

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except
Salt Lake City, Burglary 2d Degree, December 1, 1925.
