First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of May
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. White presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An indeterminate
term of One to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. H. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Pyron P. Baird

I was convicted under the name of Frank Blair

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except One charge

Dec 1st 1925 Was paroled after
