Application of Delbert Peterson #4907

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Rape

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of September,  
A. D. 1927, at Provo, County of Utah  
and State of Utah, in the <sup>Fourth</sup> Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George P. Parker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Delbert Peterson  
I was convicted under the name of Delbert Peterson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: George Maasom

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
