A. D. *1925*, at *Brigham City* County of *Box Elder*  
and State of Utah, in *1st Judicial District* Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable *Melvin C. Harris* presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to *five to life*

and thereafter was imprisoned in the *Utah State Prison*

Fourth-Honorable *Leroy D. Young* prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is *Alfred Vincent*

I was convicted under the name of *Virgil Seward*

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: *Albert Wingate and Elmer Nassau*

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except *Burglary*
