Application of Virgil Seward No. 4657

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of January
A. D. 1926, at Brigham City County of Bohemia
and State of Utah, in 1st District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Glenwood A. Seward
I was convicted under the name of Virgil A. Seward

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Charles Nassau - Albert Ungate

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
