First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt to Commit Rape.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Ninth day of November
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Third District, Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable McKone presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months to Three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Varnot prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank Tate.

I was convicted under the name of Frank Tate.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
