Application of Frank Tate No. 5280

and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th, day of November,
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Ray Vancott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Frank Tate
I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
