Application of George Swink

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the eleventh day of February A. D. 1927, at Castle Dale County of Emery and State of Utah, in The eleventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dailworth Woolley presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is George Swink

I was convicted under the name of George Swink

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am now serving
