Application of George Swink #4816

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of February, A. D. 1927, at Castle Dale, County of Emery and State of Utah, in ~~the~~ the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.
