Application of George Swink No. 1816

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary and agree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of February, A. D. 1927, at Castle Dale, County of Darcy and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Lilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Swink I was convicted under the name of same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
