County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate term not to exceed five
years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of George Swick
